Dear Parents,

We are thrilled to begin the new academic session of 2024-25 and look forward to welcoming our students to campus. Please familiarize yourselves with the following important reporting guidelines to ensure a smooth and organized start:

REPORTING SCHEDULE:

- **9th June, 2024:** 10 AM to 3 PM (Classes: 10th & 12th)
 - **12th June, 2024:** 10 AM to 3 PM (Classes: 8th, 9th & 11th)
 - **13th June, 2024:** 10 AM to 3 PM (Classes: 5th, 6th, & 7th)
1. Students need to report on time to avoid crowding and inconvenience to others.
 2. During Reporting, **Only 2 members are permitted along with the student.**
 3. A mandatory Medical Fitness Certificate must be presented at the time of reporting.
 4. Parents should furnish any recent illness reports of the ward.
 5. Advised for your ward to get vaccinated for seasonal diseases / influenza vaccination and chicken pocks (2 doses) 3 months apart.
 6. Students with skin or any other diseases are advised not to report until their treatment is complete.
 7. In special cases, it is recommended to carry a doctor's prescription and prescribed medicines
 - 8. Holiday Homework / Assignments to be submitted to the respective subject teachers on Reporting Day. Also carry the text books & note books without fail.**
 9. Make sure all the Garments (Uniform, Civil dresses) are duly stitched with GR Tags to avail of the laundry facility smoothly, and belongings should be marked with GR Number.
 10. Students who received the Pooja kit should remember to bring it.
 11. Seasonal (Rainy) ware and care is recommended
 12. Only Limited quantity of dry fruits except Pista are permitted.
 13. Maintain a decent haircut and clipped nails.
 14. Pocket Money to be maintained Rs.10000 & Rs.2300 to be deposited towards Uniform Stitching Charges (applicable to both old and new students)

15. Homemade food/snacks and fast food sachets are strictly prohibited. Violations will incur fines and disciplinary action.
16. Round neck T-shirts, Black colored Shirts/T-Shirts & Torned Jeans are strictly not permitted
17. More than recommended items and quantity are not permitted
18. Electronic Gadgets, Camera, Smart Phones, Smart Watches, Pen Drives, Headphones, Currency Wallets and Gold Ornaments, White Board & Permanent Markers are strictly banned.
19. NRI students must deposit their passports and wallets with the authorized personnel and will receive a receipt.
20. Parents/Guardians are expected to leave the campus promptly after completing the reporting process.
21. Accommodations for outstation parents are not available on campus.
22. Allocation of the hostel room will be intimated at the reporting counter
23. Parents are requested to park their vehicles in Parking Area Only.
24. Your cooperation for the safety of students is highly appreciable.
25. **Black Shirts, Collar less T-Shirts & Torned Jeans are strictly prohibited to be worn.**
