Circular to Parents: Reporting Guidelines and PT-1 Exam Schedule

Dear Parents, Jai Swaminarayan!

We appreciate your continued support in ensuring the progress and discipline of our students. As we approach the reporting dates, kindly adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. **Timely Reporting**: Please report on time as per the specified schedule:
 - 14th July: Between 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM
 - o 15th July: Between 7:30 AM and 8:30 AM
- 2. **Late Reporting Policy**: Late reporting is strictly prohibited. To maintain discipline and encourage punctuality, a fine of ₹500/- per day will be imposed for late arrivals.

3. Appearance and Hygiene:

- o Ensure your child has a decent haircut and clipped nails.
- o All clothes must bear the GR Tags (if not already done).

4. Health Measures:

- o Confirm that your ward has received the influenza vaccination.
- o If your child has any skin issues, provide the doctor's fitness certificate.
- For existing health conditions, carry the doctor's prescription and necessary medicines.

5. Essential Items to Carry:

- o Body scrubber, cloth drying clips (6 nos), and a small umbrella.
- o Monsoon wear and care essentials.
- Swimming costumes,
- o White kurta and pyjama (mandatory) for cultural activities.

6. Items Not Permitted:

- Torned jeans, round neck or black color T-shirts with or without writing.
- o Food items like pista or any other snacks.
- Perfumes, electronic Bluetooth gadgets (including wristbands and smartwatches / mobiles), and other electronic instruments.
- o Avoid carrying hard cash or valuable items.

Important Note: Parents, please inform your wards about the prohibited items. Any confiscated items will not be returned, and fines will be imposed.

Additional Information: As PT-1 exams and revision commence from **16th July, 2024**, reporting on time is crucial. Your child's attendance during this period directly impacts their final report card. Let's work together to ensure their success.
