(Classes Resume at 1:00 PM)

- 1. Students need to report on time to avoid crowding and inconvenience to others.
- 2. During Reporting, **Only 2 members are permitted along with the student**.
- 3. Parents should furnish any recent illness reports of the ward at the time of reporting for further care.
- 4. Advised for your ward to get vaccinated for seasonal diseases/Influenza vaccination (2 doses) 3 months apart.
- 5. Students with skin or any other contagious diseases are advised not to report until their treatment is complete.
- 6. In special cases, it is recommended to carry a doctor's prescription and prescribed medicines
- 7. Holiday Homework / Assignments to be submitted to the respective subject teachers on Reporting Day. Also carry the text books & note books without fail.
- Make sure all the Garments (Uniform, Civil dresses) are duly stitched with GR Tags to avail of the laundry facility smoothly, and all belongings should be marked with GR Number.
- 9. Students who received the Pooja kit should remember to bring it.
- 10. Seasonal (Rainy) ware and care, handy umbrella are recommended
- 11. Only Limited quantity of dry fruits except Pista are permitted.
- 12. Maintain a decent haircut and clipped nails.
- 13. Pocket Money to be maintained Rs.10000 & Rs.3300 to be deposited towards Uniform Stitching Charges those who have given for stitching in the campus (applicable to both old and new students)
